Internships take place during the following time periods:

- Fall Semester: August - December
- Spring Semester: January - May

If students are interested in participating in a Fall Semester Internship, they must reach out to Ms. Miranda by **May 31st of the following school year**.

If students are interested in participating in a Spring Semester Internship, they must reach out to Ms. Miranda by **October 31st of the previous semester**.

Interest in an internship does not automatically guarantee that you will be placed in one. Internships are given based on availability, academic standing, grade level, and a first come first serve basis.
